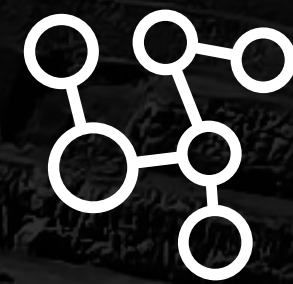

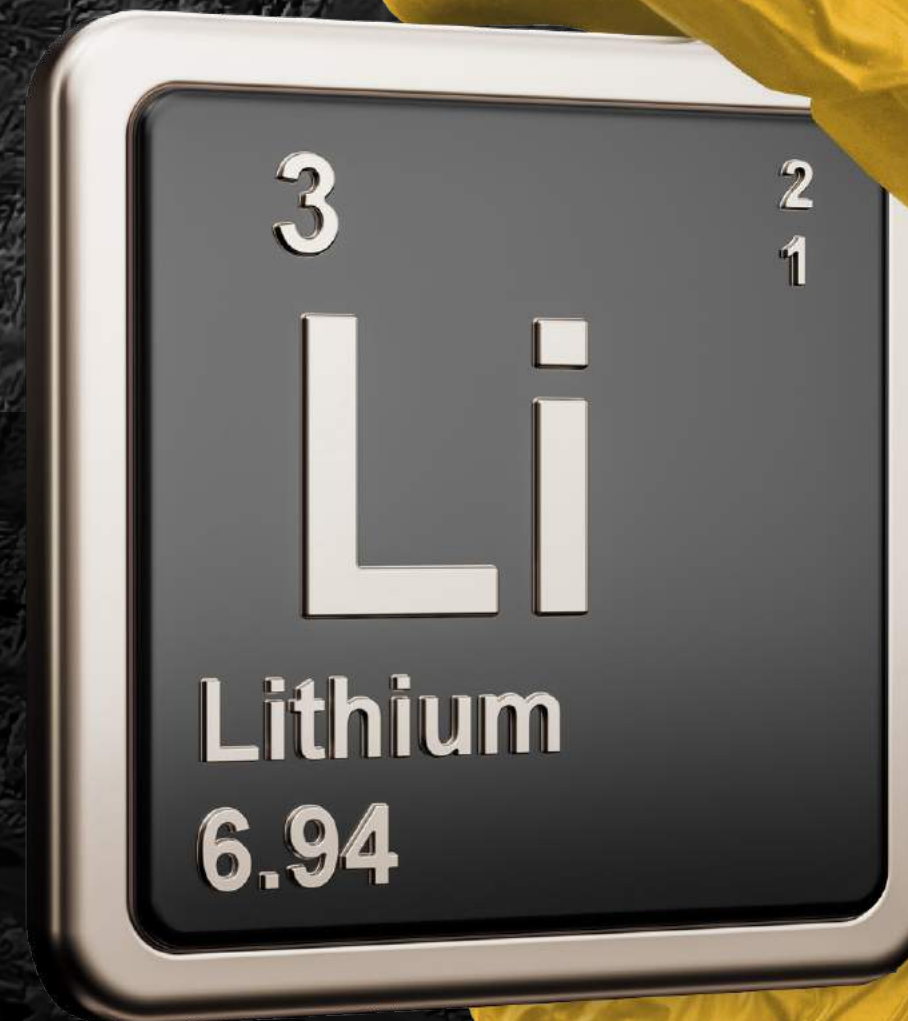
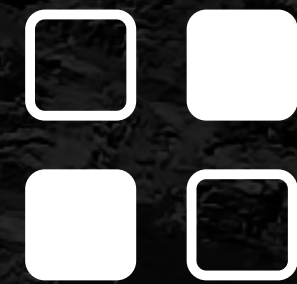

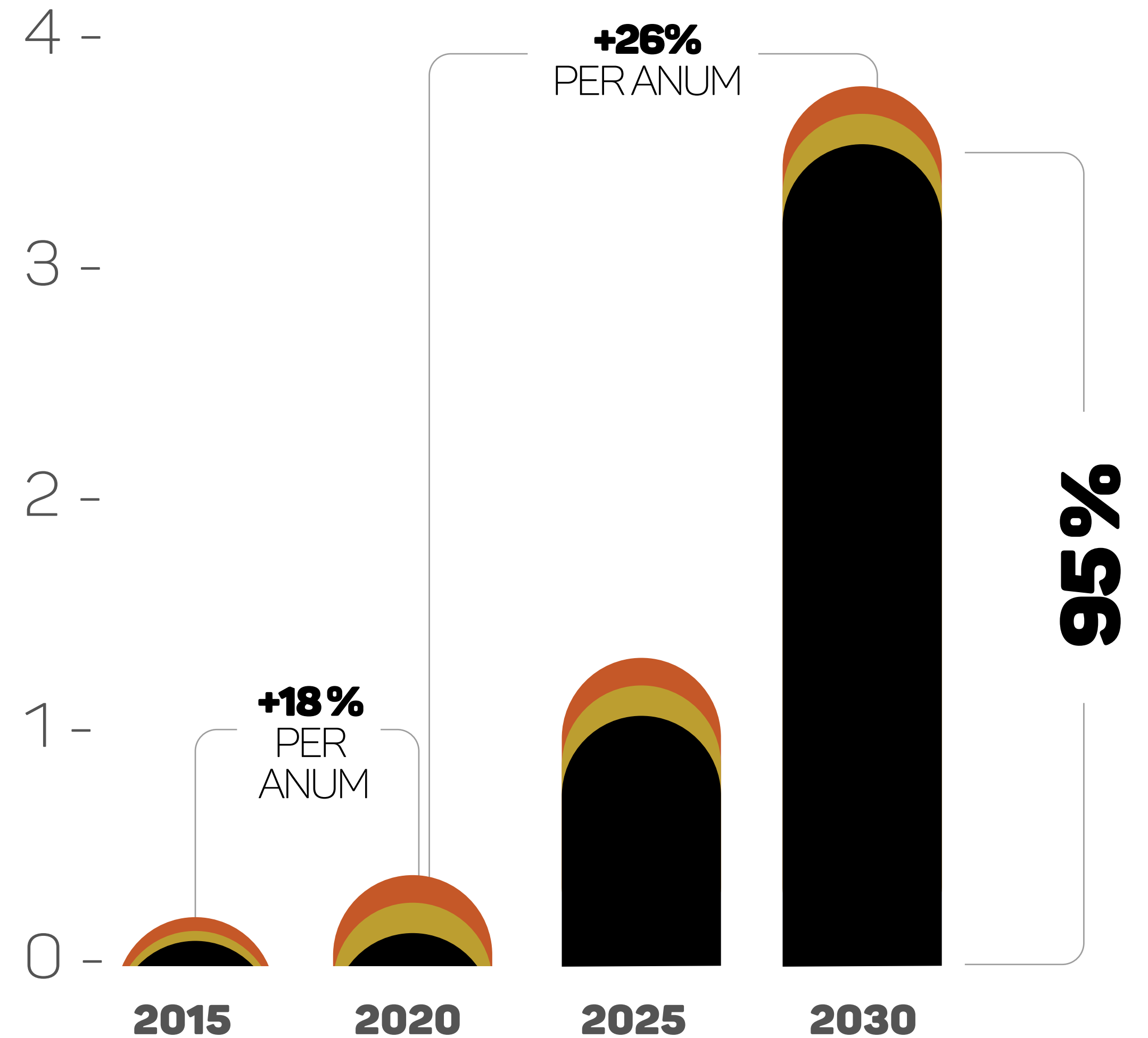

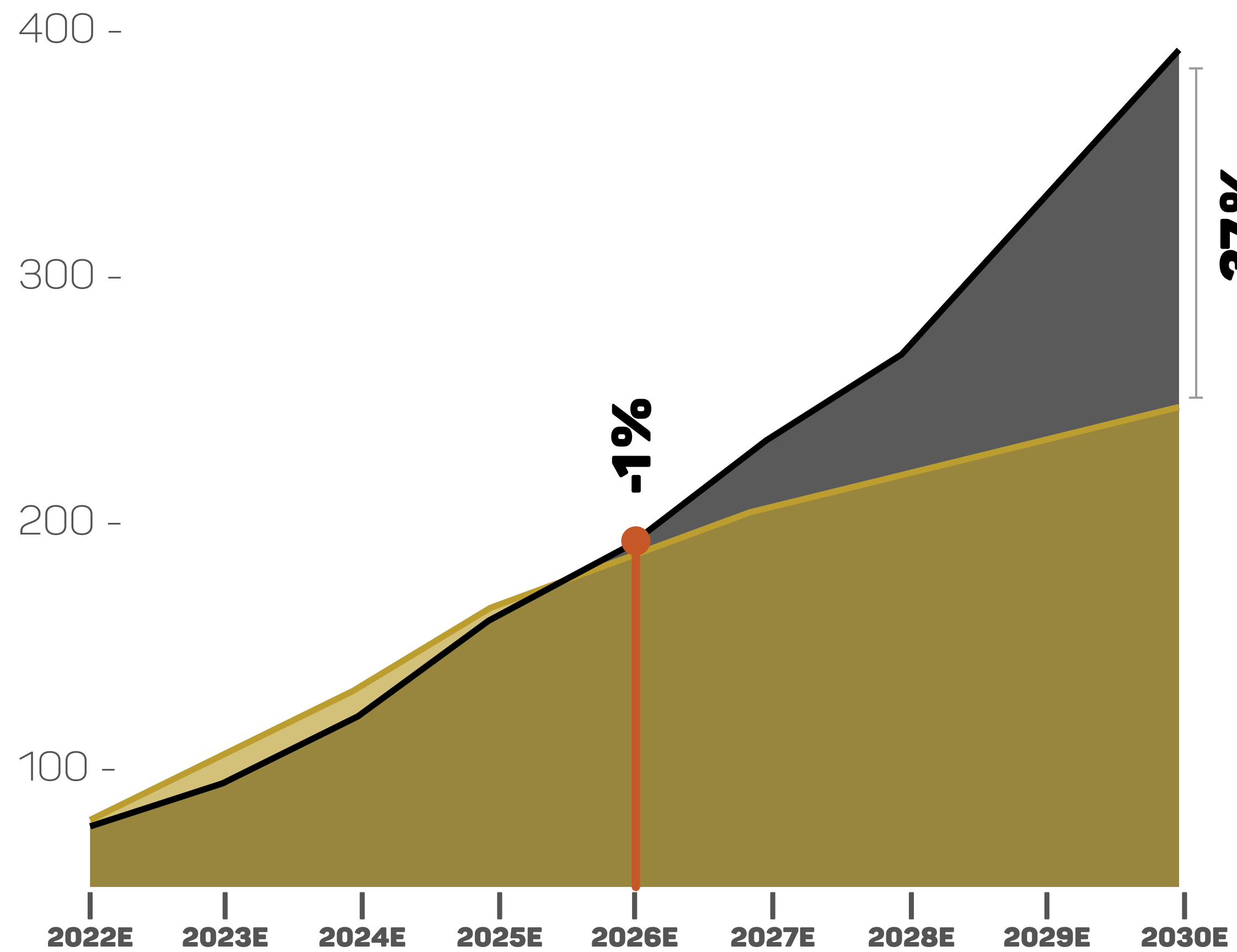
BATTERIES EXPECTED TO ACCOUNT FOR 95% OF LITHIUM DEMAND

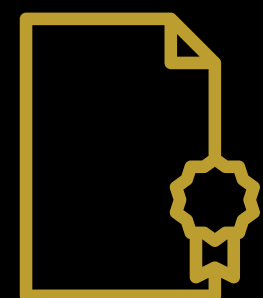

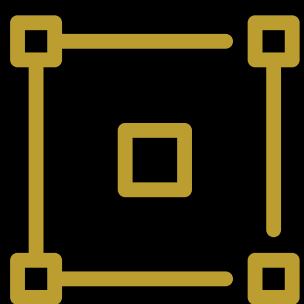

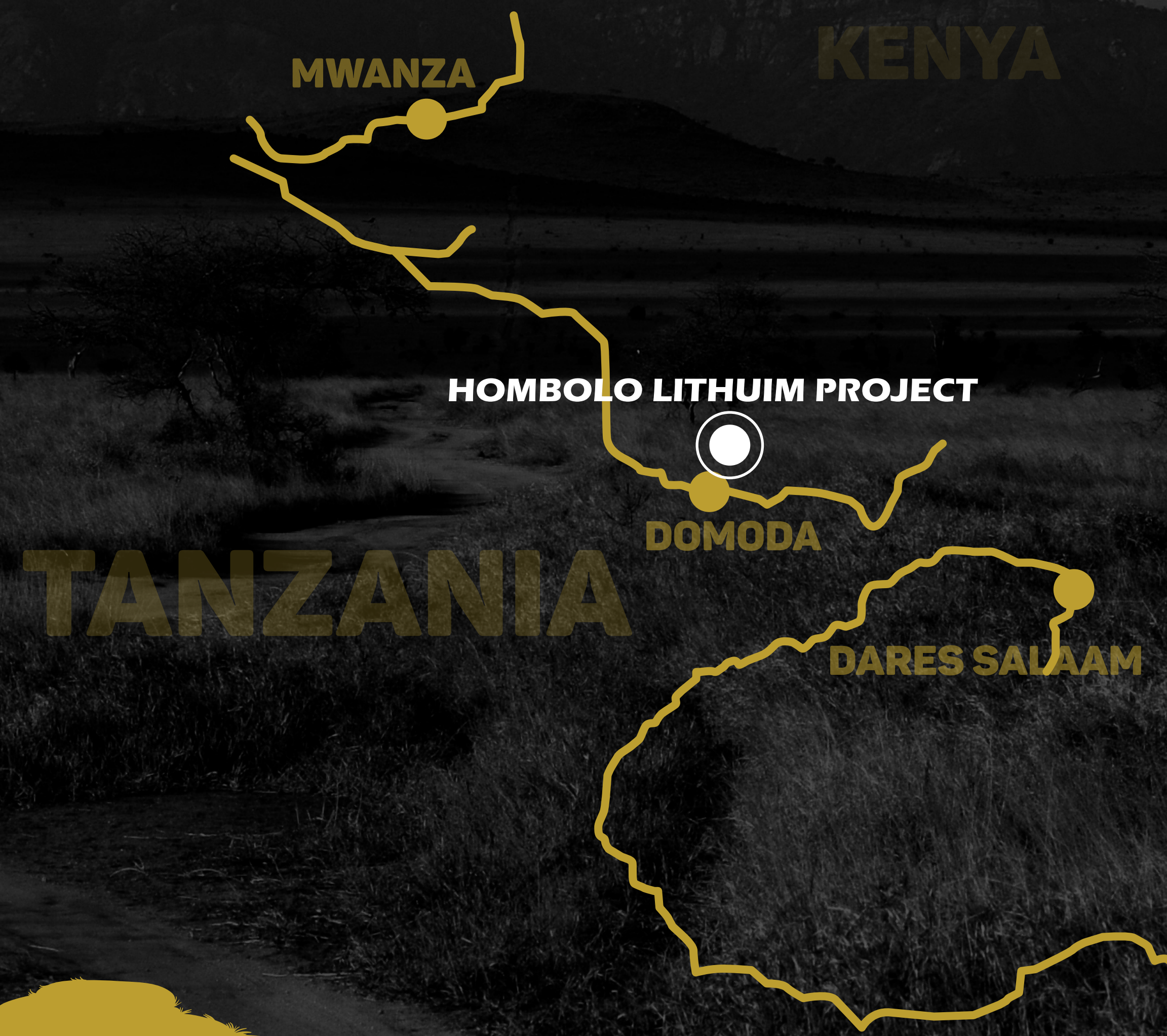
